

ROAD INFO - AURIS-EN-OISANS AND ACCESS TO ALPE D'HUEZ

Tour de France 2026

Stages 19 and 20

24 and 25 July 2026

Detailed information

Road closures and restrictions

Grenoble / D1091 - On 24/07, road closed to traffic **between Rochetaillée and Le Bourg-d'Oisans** from 2:15 pm to 6 pm. On 25/07, road closed **between Livet and le Bourg-d'Oisans** from 6:30 am, reopening late in the evening.

Route du Col d'Ornon / D526 - On 24/06, road closed to traffic between **Valbonnais and le Bourg-d'Oisans** from 12:15 pm to 6 pm. On 25/07, closure **between Pont de Oulles and la Paute** from 6:30 am, reopening late in the evening.

Chambon et Hautes Alpes / D1091 - Route fermée à la circulation **uniquement le 25/07** à partir de 11 h 15 entre le Clapier d'Auris et le Lautaret (Accès Auris possible par Briançon / La Grave jusqu'à 11h15)

Route de La Garde / D211a - Road closed to traffic **from 17/07 at 12 pm**, except for local residents.

Vallée du Ferrand / D25a - Road closed to traffic **only on 25/07** between le Chambon and le Perron.

Tour du signal de l'Homme et gorges de Sarenne - Pastoral tracks closed to motorised traffic at the Auris resort and on the D211e (near the Chapelle St Géraud), but accessible to pedestrians and cyclists. As the Sarenne area is strictly off-limits to the public during the stages, access via the Sarenne gorges footpath will be **closed**.

Route du Col de Sarenne - Road and pastoral track closed to motorised traffic from 16/07, from Le Perron and Le Cluy up to l'Alpe d'Huez. These areas are **strictly off-limits to the public** on 24/07 and 25/07, **with no pedestrian, cycling, or vehicle access permitted** on those days.

Access to Alpe d'Huez from Auris-en-Oisans

By ski lift

The simplest and most comfortable way to attend the grand finish of each Tour de France stage at the Alpe d'Huez from Auris-en-Oisans is to take the three ski lifts – Auris Express, Les Louvets, and Alpaouris – specially opened for the occasion to allow for a calm and pleasant crossing.

Lift opening hours: 9 am to 7 pm Journey time (one way): 30 min

Access: on presentation of a valid pass (purchase procedures overleaf)

Day pass or 2-day pass "Espace Alpe d'Huez", or return pass Alpe d'Huez → Auris. There is no round-trip pass available.

On foot

You can also reach the Alpe d'Huez via a walking route through the Col de Maronne, Le Rosai, and Pont Romain. This will bring you to Huez, where you can watch the finish in the final hairpin bends, or take the free Huez Express cable car to reach the resort!

Distance: 5.5 km Journey time (outbound): 2 h 15
Journey time (return): 2 h 45 or 30 min by chairlift

Elevation gain: 220 m Elevation loss: 330 m



More info

Route includes steep sections and is intended for fit walkers. For inexperienced walkers, children, and people with reduced mobility, crossing by ski lift is strongly recommended.
